Breakfast @ Qaisariyat Al Rashid – Al Khobar 9:00 AM

- Al-Rashid Mall is one of the most important malls in the gulf area and has been built on the most advanced criteria in the shopping centers, and having Al Qaisariya in the mall is the combination of old souk and modern shopping center under one ceiling.

AlFelwah & AlJowharah Museum – Dammam 11:00 AM
